# Tax-Exempt Fixed Income

The Tax-Exempt Fixed Income strategy is a portfolio of investment-grade fixed income securities issued by state and local governments throughout the United States. The strategy focuses on state and local general obligation (GO) and essentialservice revenue (REV) bonds. Bonds are laddered by maturity, with portfolio duration maintained from short to broad market maturity ranges. The strategy offers effective risk management while providing income exempt from federal taxes.
